Members of the Advisory Council are expected to attend a good proportion of events operating in the region. There are a number of benefits of Council membership, such as discounts on some events in the region, plus time volunteered contributes to CPD credits. A minimum one year term is expected starting January 1<sup>st</sup> 2018, with a maximum term of six years.
